The special meeting of the Dysart City Council was called to order by Mayor T. Glenn, with Council Members S. Stoner, S. Dabney, D. Neegaard, J. Alpers, and M. Wankowicz present.

Motion by Dabney, second from Alpers, to approve the agenda: five ayes.

Motion by Wankowicz, second from Neegaard, to approve renewal of Dollar General cigarette permit: five ayes.

After discussion regarding limited parking around the park during the 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration, the Council denied the parking request from L. Wilson for the east side of the park. Hatch Grading will be making entrance accommodations for rides on the west side of the park that could be used.
