The special meeting of the Dysart City Council was called to order by Mayor T. Glenn, with Council Members Petersen, Gingrich, Hennessy and Wankowicz present. Dabney absent.

Motion by Wankowicz, second from Hennessy, to approve the agenda: four ayes, Dabney absent.

C. Ollendieck, Tama Co. Economic Development, introduced B. Torres to the Council. Torres will be taking over Terry's Food Center in July with plans to bring new ideas to the store, including barbeque. Ollendieck also gave an update on various community projects she is helping with, including the Jump Start Tama County three-month campaign that will hopefully increase awareness about interesting places to visit, eat and experience throughout Tama County.

L. Piphon also spoke with the Council regarding the little kid's summer recreation program. Council directed Piphon to bring her ideas to the next meeting to discuss more.

Resolution No. 2020-30, A Resolution authorizing and approving a Loan Agreement, providing for the issuance of \$500,000 General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2020 and directing the levy of taxes to pay the same, was introduced and motion made for adoption by Wankowicz, second from Petersen. Resolution No. 2020-31, A Resolution Approving Transfer, was introduced and motion made for adoption by Gingrich, second from Hennessy. RCV: four ayes, Dabney absent. Resolution No. 2020-31 adopted.

Motion by Petersen, second from Gingrich, to approve Bottom's Up Add-On liquor license and request to block a portion of Main Street for Watermelon Fest 8/1/20: four ayes, Dabney absent.

Motion by Hennessy, second from Petersen to approve a one-week summer softball camp hosted by K. Martin for girls sixth through eighth grades: four ayes, Dabney absent.

Council members discussed wages and benefits for the upcoming fiscal year. Motion by Wankowicz, second from Petersen, to introduce and adopt Resolution No. 2020-32, A Resolution Setting Wages & Salaries for Fiscal Year 2020/2021. RCV: four ayes, Dabney absent. Resolution No. 2020-32 adopted.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Glenn declared the meeting adjourned.
