All Night Parking Prohibited

Per City Code Sec. 26-195., no person except physicians or other persons on emergency calls shall park a vehicle on any street or alley between the hours of **2 a.m. and 6 a.m.** of any day during the period of time from *November 15th to April 1st.*

Utility Meters

As you are shoveling any snow, please remember to clear a path to your utility meters and try to keep gates clear and unlocked, as meters are read around the 15th of every month. This ensures that we have correct readings for your utility billing and makes it easier for our reader to find your meters.

Sidewalk Snow Removal

Per City Code Sec. 24-38., it is the duty of the abutting property owner to clean their sidewalk of any accumulations. If the owner fails to comply within 24 hours after the end of the snow/ice storm, an officer authorized by the Council may remove accumulations without notice to the property owner and the cost shall be assessed to the property owner.

Please be on the lookout for any water main breaks you may see this time of year. If you see any water running down the street, please call City Hall (476-5690) and report the location. For after hours or weekends, call (319) 476-7710.

Help keep your community safe by keeping the fire hydrants clear of snow during the winter months. Take just a few moments to shovel around the hydrant on your block. This will save the fire fighters crucial time if there is a fire in your neighborhood or home.

Notes from Serious Sanitation

With the possibility of snowfall, please keep your recycling and garbage containers within plain sight at your curb, especially if you use white bags. Also, please try to keep garbage receptacles covered so that they don't fill with snow or water.

Remember to have your garbage set out by 7AM for pickup!
