LAWN & GRASS CLIPPINGS

According to City Code Section 18-2 (8): Unless a variance is allowed by resolution of the council, grass, weeds, brush, or other plants, except trees, shall be cut, mowed, and maintained so as to not exceed the following height specifications:

Developed Residential Areas – not to exceed 6 in.
Undeveloped Resid. Areas – not to exceed 8 in.
Business and Industrial Area – not to exceed 6 in.
Agricultural Areas – not to exceed 12 in.

Also, please **blow your grass clippings back onto your lawn and not into the street where they can be washed into the storm sewer and cause damage. Thank you.

GOLF CARTS

Ordinance No. 319 Section 26-351

*Shall be equipped with a slow-moving vehicle sign & a bicycle safety flag, the top of which shall be a minimum of five feet from ground level.

*Shall have adequate brakes.

*Shall not be operated upon any city street which is a primary road extension through the city. They may cross such a primary road extension. Highway 21 and X Avenue are hereby designated as primary road extension in the city.

*Operated on city streets only between sunrise and sunset.

*Operating person must have valid driver's license.

*No one standing on Golf Carts when vehicle is moving or sitting on another person.

*No person under 2 years old shall be riding.

Open Burning Regulations

As we enter the fall leaf-raking season, we ask you to be considerate of your neighbors when burning—landscape and yard waste should be burned in a relatively short time frame and not left smoldering for extended periods of time. The portions of the Dysart City Code pertaining to burning yard waste and recreational fires are outlined below:

Section 28-457. OPEN BURNING PROHIBITED. No person shall allow, cause, or permit open burning of combustible materials.

The following shall be permitted exceptions:

LANDSCAPE/YARD WASTE. The disposal by open burning of landscape waste and yard waste originating on the premises; however, the burning of landscape waste produced in clearing, grubbing, and construction operations shall be limited to areas located at least one-fourth (1/4) mile from any inhabited building. Rubber tires shall not be used to ignite landscape waste.

No burning shall occur on city streets.

RECREATIONAL FIRES. Open fires for cooking, heating, recreation, and ceremonies, provided they comply with the limits for emission of visible air contaminants established by the State Dept. of Natural Resources.
